

Release 10: Changes to the Buyer Interface

While most of the Four51 application is very configurable, sometimes it is necessary to make changes that will affect all users of a certain interface. The following list includes those items that will affect buyer users immediately following Release 10. Please review the list and logon to Staging to determine how these changes may impact your business.

1. **Quick Order Entry:** The quick order entry form has been upgraded. The form now allows a buyer user to place any product in a shopping cart rather than being limited to static products without variations. Additionally, the smart search functionality has been applied to the product search box which means the user does not have to know the exact product ID in order to find the product.
2. **Editing a Variable Line Item in a Shopping Cart:** Prior to Release 10, if a buyer user clicked on a variable product that had already been added to the cart and then clicked the Edit link, when the user clicked Save he or she would be presented with the "Add to Order" button which would create a duplicate line item. After Release 10, the "Add to Order" button will now be a "Save" button which will **not** create an additional line item but will instead update the existing line item.
3. **Credit Card Authorization:** The amount that is authorized on Saved Credit Cards or Orders Awaiting Approval with a credit card payment method has been changed from \$0.01 to \$1.00. This change was made to accommodate foreign currency exchange rates which were causing problems when the value was below \$0. The buyer user will not see a change on the application but they may notice a change on a credit card transaction statement. Credit card authorizations are automatically released within an average of seven to 10 days.
4. **Order View Page:** For buyer users with coupon and/or gift card functionality available to them, the discount information will always appear after the Tax field on the Order View page. Previously, the discount field was moved to different locations based on the configuration.
