

Release Notes: Minor Release 9.1, January 2009

Based on customer feedback following Release 9, Four51 has put together a release that contains items to improve usability as well as keep the application current with industry changes. The change is scheduled for the evening of Thursday, January 29, 2009.

Feature Name	Description
Address Selector Enhancements	The search functionality on the address selector has been updated. The search appears on the buyer interface during checkout as well as various places on the admin interface when the total number of addresses is greater than 50.
Cardholder Name field for Credit Cards	New, optional field available for users paying with a credit card. The field will appear and be required if the "Prompt for Cardholder Name with credit card information" permission is assigned.
Updated Four51 Logon Page	The Four51 Logon page has been updated to match the new public website.
Usability Enhancements	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The user list on the Edit Spending Account page has been changed to First Name Last Name and is sorted alphabetically. 2. Product Catalog page was updated to allow drag and drop of the folder OR the item name in Firefox or Safari.
Delete Projects	Projects that are unassigned to any products are able to be deleted.
Postal Code Required for Canadian Addresses	When a buyer user selects Canada for the country, the postal code field is required.
DHL - Actual Rates Removed	As of January 30, 2009 DHL will no longer support domestic shipping. The option for DHL - Actual Rates is removed from the application and existing ship methods with the option will have it removed.
Disable Inventory for resellers of Open Network Catalog products	Inventory can be tracked by the product owner and may not be manually changed by resellers.
Product Report change for Open Network Catalog owners	The Product Report has been updated to allow Open Network Catalog owners to view a report of the products in a catalog.
